Frequently Asked Questions

Question: Where is the Valentine Theatre Located?

Answer: Valentine Theatre is located at the corner of Superior and Adams Street in downtown Toledo.

Question: Where do I park?

Answer: Metered parking is free that day. There will be some handicap parking available in front of Valentine Theatre. There will also be some free parking for shuttle vans. There is paid parking for \$5-\$7 across the street (Superior) from Valentine Theatre.

Question: What times do the doors open?

Answer: The outside doors will open at 1:00. The seating will begin at 1:30.

Question: Will I need a ticket?

Answer: There are no tickets. Reservations need to be made in advance to get added to a list. All seats need to be reserved and paid in advance.

Question: May I bring my family?

Answer: This is a family event and you are encouraged to bring your family. We only ask that you limit it to your family so that as many children and adults with special needs can attend.

Question: What about handicap seating?

Answer: There will be limited handicap seating available. When making the RSVP, please let the person know if a wheel chair or other special accommodations will be needed for your group.

Question: How long is the performance?

Answer: The performance will be about 90 minutes. There will be a pause between Act 1 and Act 2.

Question: Will there be a coat check?

Answer: There will be a free coat check in the basement of Valentine Theatre.

Will I get a chance to meet the performers?

Answer: After the performance some of the performers will be in the Grand Foyer to meet.
