## **Mandatory Dress Code**

<u>Primary 1&2</u>: Plain light pink leotard, pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers. <u>NO</u> skirts, t-shirts, sweats, shorts or leg warmers. Hair should be pulled away from the face and off the neck. Long hair should be secured in a bun. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit.

Girls/Ladies: Solid color leotard, (Elementary in BLACK), pink tights with feet, pink ballet slippers.

<u>NO</u> skirts, t-shirts, sweats, shorts or leg warmers except for adult students. Hair should be pulled away from the face and neck and secured tightly to the head in a bun. No ponytails. Please have your teacher check your ballet slippers for a proper fit. Beginning pointe students MUST have their shoes approved before ribbons are sewn. Large dangle earrings or chunky jewelry are not permitted.

<u>Boys/Men:</u> Solid white T-shirt, black tights or shorts, black or white ballet shoes. All males, 10 and older must wear a dance belt.

## **Basic Policies**

<u>Make-ups:</u> All missed classes must be made up in the same level or the level below within the 18-week semester. **You must contact the office to schedule.** If make-ups due to illness cannot be covered in other

classes speak with your teacher about YouTube links or other options

<u>Refunds:</u> None. Credit will be issued for the following semester for serious illness or injury. A doctor's note must be provided.

<u>Placement:</u> *BTT* faculty determines class placement levels for all students.

<u>Bad Weather:</u> Check BTT's Facebook page and local TV stations for cancellation information. Decisions for afternoon classes are made after the noon news and weather forecast.

# Covid-19

<u>Be healthy</u>: Check temperature before arriving. If you don't feel well, STAY HOME <u>Be prompt:</u> Check-in for Studios A & C begin 10 minutes before class, Studio B 5 minutes <u>Come/ dressed in ballet attire</u>: Bring ballet shoes. No changing in bathrooms, no lost and found <u>Wear your mask</u>: A mask is required at all times and may be removed when class begins <u>Bring water</u>: Drinking fountains are closed

Bring 2 towels/yoga mats: One to place personal items in waiting area, one for stretching in the studio Maintain 6' for social distancing at ALL times

<u>Practice excellent hygiene:</u> Use hand sanitizer, wash/scrub hands often, keep your hands away from your face, minimize touching surfaces

<u>Listen to your teachers:</u> Your teachers are working on ways to keep you and others safe while dancing BTT is cleaning and wiping down barres and highly touched surfaces between classes for your safety

## Ballet Theatre of Toledo COVID-19 Protection and Disclaimer Form

COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is highly contagious, and officials are concerned regarding the ease of spread of this disease particularly through person-to-person contact. Thus government and health agencies have taken precautions and recommended certain behaviors be followed, such as social distancing, to help prevent the spread of this disease.

In order to make our reopening of in-class instruction as safe as possible, Ballet Theatre of Toledo ("BTT") has put the following new guidelines for students in place. Students <u>MUST</u> adhere to these guidelines in order to participate in in-class instruction:

- Parents of students or students themselves (if above the age of 18), must take the student's temperature and conduct a health assessment BEFORE arriving at BTT for inclass instruction. Students will be asked questions upon arrival regarding any potential symptoms they may have been experiencing and participation in class will depend upon said responses. Parents and/or students should take into consideration the health of all persons in their household and with whom the student has come into contact when conducting the health assessment and deciding whether (s)he should participate in class. This assessment must occur before **every** class the student wishes to participate in at BTT.
- Ballet barres have been marked to allow students to follow social distancing recommendations, and students must utilize these markings to ensure they are practicing proper social distancing while at the barre.
- Students must use the hand sanitizer at the front desk upon entering the building
- Students must wear a facial covering when entering and exiting the building and any time the student is not in class (e.g. when stretching waiting for class to begin). Face masks must cover the students mouth and nose anytime that they are being worn. Wearing a mask below one's nose does not constitute compliance with this requirement.
- Students may not enter into or use prohibited areas including the changing rooms and the water fountain.
- Due to the closing of the changing rooms, students must arrive dressed and ready for class and appropriately utilize the stretching and front lobby area for personal belongings.
- Students must bring their own water bottle and may not refill their water bottle at the drinking fountain or any other faucet.
- Students must bring a yoga mat or a towel for <u>both</u> their personal belongings and for use in the studio to stretch and/or to change shoes.
- Students must utilize provided sanitary wipes to wipe down the area they used at the barre after every class. If a student is taking multiple classes in a row, (s)he must use the same portion of the barre for each class. Students should not lean against the barre while waiting for an exercise in the center or unnecessarily touch the barre during any portion of class.
- Students must follow all other instruction provided to the students in and out of the classroom including, but not limited to, instruction given regarding social distancing, personal hygiene, and other preventative measures.

BTT has put the above preventative measures into place to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and to attempt to keep both students and staff healthy. <u>However</u>, BTT cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending classes at BTT could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge that I understand that contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending BTT and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and/or death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at BTT may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, BTT employees, volunteers, and other students and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death) illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at BTT ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my child(ren), I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless BTT, its employees, agents, and representative, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of BTT, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any BTT activity.

I further acknowledge the above listed preventative measures that BTT has put into place to attempt to protect myself, my child(ren), its staff, and other students and their families from the spread of COVID-19. I understand that if my child(ren) fails to follow the preventative measures put into place as listed above that (s)he may be asked to leave the in-class instruction and that it will be at the discretion of BTT staff to allow him/her to participate in future in-class instruction after such an infraction. I understand that my child(ren) will still have been considered "present" for the class even if (s)he is subsequently asked to leave due to failure to comply with the above listed measures.
